

## Heritage Trail Scavenger Hunt Instructions

Each question is tied to a particular museum. When you find the answer or the object for the question, have the docent stamp your Scavenger Hunt in the box for the museum\*. Although each Scavenger Hunt has ten questions, you only need to complete seven questions. Once you have seven questions answered, write your name, address and telephone number on the Scavenger Hunt. You may turn your completed Scavenger Hunt into the last museum you visited. In order to qualify for the drawing, you must turn in your completed Scavenger Hunt by Sunday, September 3rd at 4:00 pm.
